Designating a section of Route 220 in Clinton County, Pennsylvania, as the Frank D. O'Reilly, Jr., Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. That section of Route 220 in Clinton County, beginning at Exit 26 on Interstate 80 and ending at the Lycoming County Line, designated as segment 010 to segment 0361, a distance of 16.997 miles, is hereby designated and shall be known as the Frank D. O'Reilly, Jr., Highway.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain road signs, which shall display the name of Frank D. O'Reilly, Jr., Highway, at the beginning and the end of the section of the highway designated in section 1.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
