PROCLAMATION

By virtue of the authority vested in me by Article II, Section 4; Article IV, Section 12; and Article III, Section 12 of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, I, Robert P. Casey, Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, do hereby convene the General Assembly in special and extraordinary session, to meet in the Capitol, at Harrisburg, on November 9, 1987, at 1:00 p.m., to consider legislation upon the following subjects:

1. The subjects, rates, and amounts of taxation able to be imposed by counties, cities, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships, home rule municipalities, and school districts.

2. A comprehensive plan for allocating to municipalities and school districts (including therein the special needs of the municipalities and school districts adversely affected by an extraordinary change in their tax base) the funds appropriated in the General Appropriation Act of 1987 (Act 9A) for assisting municipalities in implementing local tax reform.
