Amending the act of June 11, 1879 (P.L.147, No.153), entitled "An act fixing the compensation of persons called to serve as coroner's jurors in this commonwealth," increasing the compensation to be paid to jurors; and providing for mileage payments.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of the act of June 11, 1879 (P.L.147, No.153), entitled "An act fixing the compensation of persons called to serve as coroner's jurors in this commonwealth," amended November 9, 1959 (P.L.1397, No.495), is amended to read:

Section 1. [(a) Be it enacted, &c., That all persons, except as hereinafter provided, summoned or notified to serve as coroner's jurors, in this commonwealth, shall be entitled to receive as compensation the sum of seven dollars (\$7) per day, and no mileage; these fees to be paid in the same manner that the fees of coroner's jurors are now paid.] A person summoned to serve as a coroner's juror shall receive compensation at the rate of nine dollars (\$9)-per day for the first three days in any calendar year he is required to report for service and twenty-five dollars (\$25) per day for each day thereafter in the calendar year that the person is required to report. In addition, a person so summoned shall be paid a travel allowance of seventeen cents-per-mile circular. The compensation and travel allowance shall be paid in the same manner that the fees of coroner's jurors are now paid.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
