HB 790

Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Boat and Fish Funds.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short title.

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Boat and Fish Funds Capital Budget Act for 1988-1989.

Section 2. Total authorizations.

The total authorizations for the capital projects in the category of public improvement projects itemized in section 3 to be acquired or developed by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Boat Fund and the Fish Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, shall be \$6,250,000.

Section 3. Itemization of Fish Commission capital projects.

The individual capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be acquired or developed by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Boat Fund and the Fish Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:

- (1) Bedford County
 - (i) Improvements to Reynoldsdale Fish Culture Station \$2,500,000
(Fish Fund - \$2,500,000)
- (2) Centre County
 - (i) Improvements to Bellefonte Fish Culture Station 1,000,000
(Fish Fund - \$1,000,000)
- (3) Cumberland County
 - (i) Improvements to Big Spring Fish Culture Station 600,000
(Fish Fund - \$600,000)
 - (ii) Improvements to Huntsdale Fish Culture Station 850,000
(Fish Fund - \$850,000)
- (4) Erie County
 - (i) Acquisition of Elk Creek Access Area 750,000
(Fish Fund - \$375,000)
(Boat Fund - \$375,000)
 - (ii) Improvements to Girard Fish Culture Station 550,000
(Fish Fund - \$550,000)

Section 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
