SB 1588

Designating a portion of the Beaver Valley Expressway in Beaver and Lawrence Counties as the James E. Ross Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The portion of State Route 60, known as the Beaver Valley Expressway, between existing State Route 60 near Beaver Falls in Beaver County northwardly to the interchange with State Route 422 near New Castle is designated and shall be known as the James E. Ross Highway.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs identifying the above portion of highway as the James E. Ross Highway upon its completion.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
