## AN ACT

## HB 2725

Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Fish Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

**Section 1. Short title.**

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Fish Fund Hatchery Improvement Capital Budget Act for 1990-1991.

**Section 2. Total authorizations.**

The total authorizations for the capital projects in the category of public improvement projects for State fish hatcheries itemized in section 3 to be developed by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission and to be financed by current revenues from the Fish Fund pursuant to executive authorizations shall be \$2,630,000.

**Section 3. Itemization of Fish Commission hatchery improvement capital projects.**
