Amending the act of June 10, 1931 (P.L.492, No.156), entitled "An act relating to the trespassing of live stock on improved lands; providing for the taking up, impounding and sale thereof; imposing duties on and fixing the fees of constables, justices of the peace, and viewers appointed in connection therewith; prescribing the procedure for repossession by the owner thereof; providing for the fixing and taxing of costs, including attorneys' fees; and repealing inconsistent legislation," further defining "live stock" to include goats.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of the act of June 10, 1931 (P.L.492, No.156), entitled "An act relating to the trespassing of live stock on improved lands; providing for the taking up, impounding and sale thereof; imposing duties on and fixing the fees of constables, justices of the peace, and viewers appointed in connection therewith; prescribing the procedure for repossession by the owner thereof; providing for the fixing and taxing of costs, including attorneys' fees; and repealing inconsistent legislation," is amended to read:

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That whenever the words "live stock" are used in this act, they shall include all cattle, horses, sheep ~~[and/or]~~, *goats and* swine of every age and sex, and shall include the plural as well as the singular, and whenever a singular noun is used in this act, it shall include also the plural thereof.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
