## AN ACT

## HB 1110

Designating State Route 56 in Seward, Westmoreland County, as the Ricky Hafer Highway; and designating State Route 711 in Seward, Westmoreland County, as Aaron Rusin Boulevard.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

## Section 1. Ricky Hafer Highway.

- (a) Declaration of policy.—The General Assembly find and declares as follows:
  - (1) Ricky Hafer graduated from Laurel Valley High School and enlisted in the United States Army in August 2002.
- (2) Private First Class Hafer, age 21, served with distinction in the 101st Airborne Division until his death on November 15, 2003, in a midair collision of two Black Hawk helicopters in Iraq.
- (b) Designation.—State Route 56 in Seward, Westmoreland County, is hereby designated as the Ricky Hafer Highway.
- (c) Signs.—The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs to indicate the designation under subsection (b). Section 2. Aaron Rusin Boulevard.
- (a) Declaration of policy.—The General Assembly find and declares as follows:
  - (1) Aaron Rusin graduated from Central Cambria High School and enlisted in the United States Army in the fall of 2003.
  - (2) Army Specialist Rusin, age 19, served with distinction in the United States Army until his death on October 10, 2004, by sniper fire while patrolling in a Humvee in Iraq.
- (b) Designation.—State Route 711 in Seward, Westmoreland County, is hereby designated as Aaron Rusin Boulevard.
- (c) Signs.—The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs to indicate the designation under subsection (b). Section 3. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
