**CHAPTER 105.**

---

**LAW ABOUT STONE HORSES RUNNING AT LARGE.**

Chap: 105 And be it &c That No person in this province or territories thereof, shall from & after the 10th day of the 8th Month next ensuing, Suffer any stone horse to run at Large after 2 years old, under 13 1/2 hands high, 4 inches to the hand, upon the penalty of five pounds.

Repealed by chapter 155, 1684. See chapter 149, 1699. Noted as repealed in A.S.P., James Logan's book of Laws of Pennsylvania dated 1741.

**CHAPTER 106.**

---

**LAW ABOUT NOTICE OF IMPORTS.**

Chap: 106 Be it &c That all provisions brought in from any other place into this Province or territories therof, West-Jersey only excepted, That shall be exposed to Sale, shall not be bought by any person Untill the same hath been here, at Least 5 days To the end that those that Live remotely may have Notice therof, and be Supplied as well as others neer at hand, And if any person so bringing any provision as aforesaid, Shall presume to Sell it, befor it hath bin here for that time, Such person shall forfeit double the value therof.

**CHAPTER 107.**

---

**LAW ABOUT SALE OF CORN.**

Chap: 107 Be it &c: That if any person within this Province or territories therof, Shall Expose to Sale any corn att the Common price,

that is not Clean drest from dust, Chaff & such Like trash, hee or shee shall pay for every such offence 5 shillings.

Confirmed by chapter 154, 1684; chapter 175, 1685; chapter 186, 1688; and chapter 191, 1690. Abrogated in 1693.

## CHAPTER 108.

---

### LAW ABOUT DEPARTERS OUT OF THE PROVINCE.

Chap: 108 And be it &c That every Person intending to depart or Leave this Province or territories thereof, shall publish his or her intention in writting affixed to the doore of the County-Court, where hee or shee inhabits, 30 days befor his or her departure, and shall have a pass under the County-Seal . . . And if any master of ship or vessell or others, shall presume to Convey or transport any person out of this province, or territories therof, without such pass, shall pay all the damages that shall happen therby.

Confirmed by chapter 154, 1684; chapter 175, 1685; chapter 186, 1688; and chapter 191, 1690. Abrogated in 1693, but accepted in Petition of Right, June 1, 1693, as chapter 55.

## CHAPTER 109.

---

### LAW ABOUT FAMILY INTESTATE SHARE OF ESTATE.

Chap: 109 And be it &c: That Whatsoever Estate any person hath in this Province and territories therof att the time of his death, Unless it appear that an equal provision be made elsewhere shall be thus disposed of, That is to Say, One third to the wife of the party deceased, One third to the Children equally, & the other third as hee pleaseth, And in Case his wife be deceased before him, two thirds shall go to the children equally & the other 3d be disposed of, as hee shall think fit, his debts being first payd.
