

Provided allways that this Law shall not extend to any member of Provincial-Council or assembly, during their attendance & Service in Provincial-Council & assembly & 4 days befor & 14 days after their Said Service and attendance therein.

CHAPTER 144.

LAW ABOUT PRODUCE FOR PAY.

Chap: 144 Wheras there is a Necessity for the Sake of Commerce in this infancy of things That the growth and produce of this Province & territories thereof, Shall pass in Lieu of Mony Be it &c: That all marchantable Wheat Rye, Indian-Corn, Barley, Oats, Pork, Beef Tobacco Shall be accompted Current pay at the Market-price, in every respective County of this Province & territories thereof.

Confirmed by chapter 154, 1684; chapter 175, 1685; and chapter 186, 1688. Chapter 191, 1690 included in among the laws to be continued to the end of the next General Assembly and twenty days after and no longer. Abrogated in 1693. Replaced by chapter 97, 1693.

CHAPTER 145.

LAW ABOUT LEGAL FORMS.

Chap: 145 To the End that plainnes & Brevity may be used, for the ease, benefit & Security both of the publick and privat, Be it &c: That all Warrants & Summonses, Arrests, Attachments Replevins, Bills Single and Obligatorie, made according to the following Draughts, Shall be held Legall and Authentick, to all intents and purposes, within this Province and territories therof

Draughts of a Bill Single & obligatory.

Know all men by these presents That I A B of &c: Carpenter doo Owe and am indebted unto D E of &c husband man in the Sum of ten pounds five Shillings to be paid to the Said D E his executors, Administrators or Assigns at or befor the &c day of &c next ensuing the date

hereof To the which payment Well and truly be made I bind my self my heirs Executors & Administrators firmly by these presents (Or, In the penal Sum of twenty pounds ten Shillings) Witness my hand and Seal this &c day of the &c month 168 being the &c year of the Kings Reign, and the &c year of the Proprietaries government.

A Warrant of Arrest

These are by the Kings Authority & in the Proprietaries Name, to Require thee to Arrest the body of A B if found in thy Bayley-week, and him Safely to keep and have at the next County-Court to be held att &c: the &c day of the &c month, Then & there as well to answer the Complaint of C D, as to stand to & abide the judgment of the Court according to Law, and to make a true Return hereof to the next County-Court, Given under my hand & Seal the &c day (ut Supra).

A Summons

These are by the Kings Authority and in the Proprietaries Name to Require thee to Appear at the next County-Court on the &c: day of the &c: Month next, To answer the Complaint of C D for withholding of &c: (due upon Bond or Bill or for goods Sold, or for work, trespass, Slander Assault and Batterie) And thereof thow art not to fail at thy perill, Given under my hand and Seal the &c day of the &c month 168 Being the &c year of the Kings reign & the &c year of the Proprietaries Government.

A Replevin

These are by the kings Authority & in the Proprietaries Name To Replevin (be it Horse, Corn &c.) the goods of C D now distrayned or impounded by A B, and to deliver them to the said C D, Provided hee give bond with Sufficient Security to prosecute the Replevin at the next County-Court to be held at &c & then & there to abide and perform the judgment of the said Court according to Law, and make a true Return hereof the next County-Court Given under my hand & Seal (ut Supra).
