

CHAPTER MCDXLVII.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SUPREME EXECUTIVE COUNCIL TO DRAW ON THE STATE TREASURER FOR AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF MONEY FOR DEFRAYING THE EXPENSE OF PURCHASING OF THE INDIANS LANDS ON LAKE ERIE.

(Section I, P. L.) Whereas the sum of twelve hundred pounds granted and appropriated by the act entitled "An act to authorize the supreme executive council to draw on the state treasurer for a sum of money for defraying the expense of purchasing of the Indians lands on Lake Erie" falls eight hundred and sixty-five pounds fifteen shillings and four pence short of perfecting the said purchase and the necessary expenses attending the same:

[Section I.] (Section II, P. L.) Be it therefore enacted and it is hereby enacted by the Representatives of the Freemen of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and by the authority of the same, That the supreme executive council of this state be and the same are hereby authorized and directed to draw an order or orders on the state treasurer for the said sum of eight hundred and sixty-five pounds fifteen shillings and four-pence, which sum shall be paid by the state treasurer out of the ten thousand pounds appropriated by the act entitled "An act to appropriate divers funds accruing and growing due to this commonwealth towards the payment of the expenses of government, and to provide a fund for other purposes"² enacted the twenty-sixth day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine.
