

CHAPTER MMCLXXXIV.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF PHILADELPHIA TO SELL AND CONVEY A CERTAIN PIECE OF GROUND THEREIN DESCRIBED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN MENTIONED.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of the county of Philadelphia be, and they are hereby, authorized to sell and convey all that part of the public landing, situate on the west side of Front street, and between Noble and Duke streets, in the township of the Northern Liberties, in such manner and way as a majority of the said commissioners, and at least three of the justices of the peace of the said county may conceive will most conduce to the public interest, and to appropriate the proceeds of such sale, in the same manner as the net proceeds of the rents of the public landings and wharves are appropriated by the third section of the act, entitled, "An act respecting the public landings and wharves, in the township of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia," passed the fourth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-six.
