CHAPTER MMDCXLVIII.

AN ACT TO REPEAL AN ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT DECLARING CHARTIER'S CREEK, IN THE COUNTIES OF WASHINGTON AND ALLEGHENY A PUBLIC HIGHWAY." (*)

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, the act, entitled "An act declaring Chartier's creek, in the counties of Washington and Allegheny, from the mouth thereof, to David Bradford's mills on the main branch thereof, a public highway;" passed the eighth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-three,⁽¹⁾ be, and the same is hereby repealed and made null and void.
