CHAPTER MMDCXCII.

AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE TO THE PROTHONOTARY OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE EASTERN DISTRICT, AND THE PROTHONOTARY OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF PHILADELPHIA.

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of five hundred dollars, each, shall be allowed to the prothonotary of the supreme court of the Eastern District, and to the prothonotary of the court of common pleas of the city and county of Philadelphia, clear of tax, in addition to the sum allowed to the said prothonotaries, by the twenty-seventh section of the act, entitled "An act to alter the judiciary system of this commonwealth," passed the twenty-fourth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and six.⁽¹⁾
