

CHAPTER MMDCCXVI.

AN ACT TO CONTINUE IN FORCE FOR A LIMITED TIME THE FIRST SECTION OF THE ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR ASCERTAINING THE RIGHT OF THIS STATE TO CERTAIN LANDS NORTH AND WEST OF THE RIVER OHIO AND ALLEGHENY AND CONEWANGO CREEK." (*)

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the first section of the act, entitled, "An act for ascertaining the rights of this state to certain lands lying north and west of the rivers Ohio and Allegheny and Conewango creek," passed the third of April, one thousand eight hundred and four,⁽¹⁾ be, and the same is hereby extended and continued in force for and during the term of one year from the first day of April next.

CHAPTER MMDCCXVII.

AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR IMPROVING THE ROAD LEADING FROM NEAR THE BALD EAGLE'S NEST IN CENTRE COUNTY, TO THE RIVER ALLEGHENY IN VENANGO COUNTY, AND A ROAD IN GREENE COUNTY.

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that the governor be, and he is hereby authorized to draw his warrant on the state treasurer, for the sum of five hundred dollars, to be paid to the commissioners of Centre county, out of any unappropriated monies
