

CHAPTER MMDCCCLXVII.

AN ACT FOR EXTENDING AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT REGULATING AND CONTINUING THE DISTRIBUTION OF DONATION LANDS." (1)

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act entitled "An act regulating and continuing the distribution of donation lands," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and five,⁽¹⁾ be, and the same is hereby extended, and all matters and things therein contained, (the limitation clause only excepted), shall be and continue in force until the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and eight.

CHAPTER MMDCCCLXVIII.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT TO THE ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR THE REGULATION OF THE MILITIA OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA." (1)

Whereas it hath been represented to the legislature, that a number of persons have been drafted to serve a tour of militia duty in the Western Expedition, in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, and subjected to the payment of heavy fines, some of whom never had notice of their being drawn and consequently no notice of the day of appeal: Therefore,
