

CHAPTER MMMXLI.

AN ACT TO PERPETUATE THE GREAT SEAL OF THIS COMMONWEALTH.

Whereas the great seal of this commonwealth is so nearly worn out, that it is necessary to renew the same; and whereas it appears that there is no description thereof on record, and it being proper that the said seal should be particularly described and established, so that the same may hereafter be more fully known and recognized: Therefore,

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the secretary of the commonwealth be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to procure the renewal of the great seal of this commonwealth, and record and deposit a description thereof in writing in his office that the same may be made perpetual.

CHAPTER MMMXLII.

AN ACT ALLOWING THE PHILADELPHIA BANK TO ESTABLISH BRANCHES.

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the president, directors and company of the Philadelphia bank to establish offices not exceeding eight in number, wheresoever they shall think proper within this commonwealth, for the purposes of discount and deposit only, and
