## CHAPTER MMMCXXI.

AN ACT TO CONTINUE IN FORCE AN ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN BALANCES OF PURCHASE MONEY YET DUE, AND REMAINING CHARGED ON LANDS WHICH HAVE BEEN PATENTED ON WARRANTS WHICH HAVE BEEN OBTAINED SINCE SURVEYS WERE ORIGINALLY MADE, IN PURSUANCE OF OLD PROPRIETARY WARRANTS AND LOCATIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES," (1) AND AN ACT, ENTITLED "AN ACT REGULATING AND CONTINUING THE DISTRIBUTION OF DONATION LANDS." (2).

Section I. (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act, entitled "An act to provide for the payment of certain balances of purchase money yet due and remaining charged on lands which have been patented on warrants which have been obtained since surveys were originally made, in pursuance of old proprietary warrants and locations, and for other purposes;" and all matters and things therein contained be, and the same is hereby continued in force until the first day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and twelve, (the limitation clause only excepted.)

Section II. (Section II, P. L.) And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the first section of the act, entitled "An act regulating and continuing the distribution of donation lands," passed March twenty-fifth, one thousand eight hundred and five, (2) and all matters and things therein contained be, and the same is hereby continued in force until the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ten.
