

CHAPTER MDCCVII.

AN ACT TO ALLOW AN ADDITIONAL INSPECTOR AT THE GENERAL ELECTIONS FOR THE DISTRICT OF SOUTHWARK.

[Section I.] (Section I. P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the electors of the district of Southwark, at the same time and place, and in the same manner as is prescribed by the fifth section of the act entitled "An act to regulate the general elections of this commonwealth and to prevent frauds therein,"¹ as directs the mode of choosing inspectors, to choose an additional inspector to serve at the general elections for the said district of Southwark; anything in any former law to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

CHAPTER MDCCVIII.

AN ACT REPEALING SO MUCH OF THE ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR RAISING AND COLLECTING OF MONEY ON THE SPECIFIED ARTICLES THEREIN MENTIONED FOR THE SUPPORT OF GOVERNMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREIN MENTIONED,"¹ AS IMPOSES A TAX UPON WRITS ISSUING OUT OF ANY OF THE COURTS OF COMMON PLEAS WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH.
