out of the fund appropriated for the support of government, in the manner prescribed and directed in and by the aforesaid recited act.

CHAPTER MDCCXXXVI.

A SUPPLEMENT TO THE ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO ENJOIN CERTAIN DUTIES ON THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES." 1

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That, from and after the passing of this act, the salary of the deputy secretary shall be nine hundred dollars per annum.

CHAPTER MDCCXXXVII.

AN ACT TO REPEAL SO MUCH OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE SUBSCRIBERS TO THE BANK OF PENNSYLVANIA" AS REQUIRES THE ATTENDANCE OF THIRTEEN DIRECTORS TO PERFORM THE DISCOUNT BUSINESS OF THE SAID BANK, AND TO AUTHORIZE A LESSER NUMBER TO DISCHARGE THAT DUTY.

Whereas it has been represented by the president and directors of the Bank of Pennsylvania, in the name and by authority of the stockholders, that great difficuties have occurred in consequence of the fifth article of the seventh section of the act of incorporation, which requires the presence of not less than
