CHAPTER MDCCCLXXIX.

A SUPPLEMENT TO THE ACT, ENTITLED, "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ASCERTAINING THE ARREARAGES OF TAXES DUE FROM THE RESPECTIVE COUNTIES OF THIS COMMONWEALTH."

Whereas the time limited by the act, entitled, "An act to provide for ascertaining the arrearages of taxes due from the respective counties of this commonwealth," passed the seventeenth of April, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, for the commissioners therein named to make return of their proceedings to the comptroller general has, on experience, been found to be too short. Therefore:

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Penusylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the powers vested in the commissioners therein named, by the act to which this is a supplement, shall be, and the same are, hereby revived, and to continue until the first day of January, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-seven.

CHAPTER MMDCCCLXXX.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN INSPECTOR OF STAVES AND HEADING.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of
