

## CHAPTER MCMLIII.

AN ACT TO CONTINUE AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT FOR OPENING AND BETTER AMENDING AND KEEPING IN REPAIR THE PUBLIC ROADS AND HIGHWAYS WITHIN THIS PROVINCE."<sup>1</sup>

[Section I.] (Section I. P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the act entitled "An act to continue the act of General Assembly entitled, 'An act for opening and better amending and keeping in repair the public roads and highways within this province'"<sup>2</sup> and everything in the same act contained (the clause of limitation thereof only excepted) shall be, and the same hereby, is, continued, for and during the term of two years from and after the enacting hereof, and from thence until the end of the next session of the general assembly, and no longer.

## CHAPTER MCMLIV.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE SALE OF SUCH OF THE BARRACK AND CITY LOTS AS REMAIN THE PROPERTY OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the surveyor general, receiver general and secretary of the land office be, and they are hereby, authorized and required, within three months from and after the passing of this act, to offer for sale, at public auction, all the barrack lots, the property of this commonwealth, within the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia, and the said lots to sell for the best price that can be obtained.
